




Primary 2/3's Weekly Learning at Home Plan

<p>Phonics (sounds) MONDAY LI: I can read and write the 'wr' (Primary 2) or Common/tricky word practise (Primary 3).</p> <p>From the lists uploaded to Seesaw, choose one of the ways to practise your spelling from the list on Seesaw. <i>Share your spelling pictures on Seesaw.</i></p> 	<p>Numeracy MONDAY LI: I can identify and write fractions</p> <p>To warm up, play this fractions game to familiarise yourself with the terms 'halves', 'quarters', 'thirds' https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</p> <p><i>Follow the instruction set for you on Seesaw.</i></p> 	<p>IDL MONDAY</p> <p><i>I can explain if I like or dislike music and say why. I can use my knowledge of beat, repetition and rhythm to create a short dance. I can explore different moves from the 80s and create a sequence of these moves.</i></p> <p>Music: Listen to some 1980s music and make up your own dance routine or exercise workout to a song of your choice. Examples: Survivor's 'Eye of the Tiger' You could try and incorporate some iconic moves from the 1980's like; Michael Jackson 'Moonwalk', the 'Sprinkler', the 'Robot' and the 'Running Man'. <i>Share a video of your dance on Seesaw</i></p>

<p>Extending Literacy Skills Wednesday</p> <p>Log into Sumdog and complete a selection of the literacy activities assigned to you.</p> <p><i>Please share pictures on Seesaw</i></p> 	<p>Outdoor Maths Wednesday LI: I can estimate how far I will walk</p> <p>You will need to do this activity with a partner. Give your partner a magic number (e.g. 100). Estimate how far you will walk to if you walk 100 steps. Count it out and find out where you finish. Were you right? Did you go further than you thought? Try it again with different numbers. Can you walk 100 steps in each direction from where you are standing?</p>	<p>Food Technologies Wednesday LI: I am learning about the Eat Well Plate to create a healthy menu for my day.</p> <p>Look at the Eatwell Plate on Seesaw and discuss the main food groups. Which are the most important? What foods should you have less of? <p>Writing Thursday LI: I can write a story about what I dream to be when I grow up</p> <p>The BFG catches dreams in the story. What dreams do you have at night?
