Take care to write neatly and to form your letters correctly</p> 	<p>1 Easter Colour by Number LI: I can add and subtract two numbers and complete a picture using an answer key.</p> <p>Look at the second page and complete the sums. Then use the answers to colour the picture using the key.</p>	<p>1. Health and Wellbeing LI: I can describe things about myself that make me special.</p> <p>Complete the page and tell me some interesting things about yourself.</p> 
<p>2. Comprehension – People Who Help Us LI: I understand what I have read. LI: I can answer questions on it.</p> <p>Read at the information on the page and then look at the questions and complete the sheet.</p> 	<p>2. Animal Money LI: I can add money amounts together to problem solve.</p> <p>Using the code page where each letter has a value, work out how much each animal costs by adding up the value of the letters in its name.</p> 	<p>2. Easter Challenge LI: I can find items in the garden or outside.</p> <p>In the garden, if you have one, or when you are out for a walk, see if you can find the different things to stick onto your challenge sheet. If you cannot find any of the items you can draw them in.</p>

Design a Book Cover/Phonics Workbook Group1 LI: I can use my knowledge of a story to create a new book cover</p> <p>Using a book or story you know well think of how the cover could look if you were the illustrator.</p> <p>Group 2 LI: I can say the sounds of letters and write them correctly. In your Phonics Work book do the Letter 'S'</p> 	<p>3 Addition – Pairs adding to 20 or Finding missing numbers. LI: I can add two numbers to make 10 or 20</p> <p>Group 1 – Find pairs of numbers which add up to 20. The numbers must be touching with one side. Group 2 – Find the missing numbers to make the correct answer of 10 or 20.</p>	<p>3. Creativity Grid</p> <p>Choose one of the items from the Creativity grid and complete it.</p>
<p>4. Writing - Poetry/Letter formation Group 1 LI: I can write a poem about Spring</p> <p>Using all of your senses (sight, hearing, smell, touch and taste) write a poem about what Spring is. What can you hear? See? Write about things you know about Spring.</p> <p>Group 2 LI: I can form my letters correctly. Complete page 1 of the letter formation booklet. Take time to write the letters correctly starting at the top and writing smoothly.</p> 	<p>4 Easy addition and subtraction/Adding numbers to 20 LI: I can add and subtract pairs of numbers</p> <p>Group 1 – take care to look at the operator sign, some are '-' and some are '+' Group 2 – Add the numbers in the top half of the page and then match the sentence to the sum in the bottom half.</p>	<p>4. Health and Wellbeing LI: I am learning to improve a skill through practise.</p> <p>Find something to throw. A ball (the bigger it is the easier), a beanbag or a favourite teddy. Find someone at home to throw the ball to. Start touching toes, then each time you successfully catch take one step back. Try it every day. Can you increase the number of successful throws and catches you manage over a week?</p>

Take your time to make each letter correctly and sound out the word as you write it.</p>	<p>5 Addition 1,2,3,4 LI: I can recall my basic maths facts.</p> <p>Use your add and subtract skills to find the answers to each little section of the picture and colour it using the correct colour – look at the colour key.
